- Information about the legal rights of students with disabilities in high school and after graduation
- **Strategies for using the IEP process** to get better outcomes in the areas of employment, further education and independent living
- Information about adult services and benefits that are available to individuals with disabilities to assist them in developing independence and the skills to successfully participate, live and work in the community
- Opportunities to practice and develop self-advocacy skills
